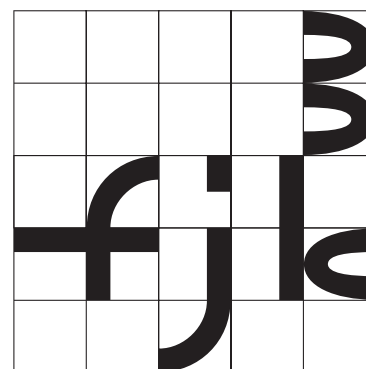

Contemporary Art Space

Philipp Fleischmann (*1985 in Hollabrunn, AT) persistently crosses and modifies the boundaries between visual art and film, and is regarded as one of the key figures of a younger generation of moving image artists. His largest solo exhibition to date provides insight into his work over the past 15 years.

13 Film Works offers a sensory experience that goes beyond conventional cinematic perception – from **conceptual reflections** on our interaction with the medium to **color spaces dissolved in light and rhythm**.

Fleischmann **gained his first experiences with film** in front of the camera as a young actor in an Austrian television series. The camera apparatus, which had been aimed at him for years, its dispositifs, and hierarchical power structures, became the starting point for his own artistic work. Fleischmann's artistic practice ranges from cinematic spatial measurements of entire buildings to fleeting cinematographic gestures and the **fusion of film and sculpture**. His works critically and yet playfully engage with themes of **inclusion and exclusion mechanisms** within institutional spaces, methods of appropriation and self-determination, **resistance to normative forms of representation**, and the possibilities of queer abstraction.

The **physical materiality of the analog film strip** is central to all of the artist's works, as is working with **self-built cameras and displays**.

Philipp Fleischmann works as an artist and filmmaker in Vienna. Since 2014, he has been the artistic director of the School Friedl Kubelka for Independent Film, where he himself studied in 2006. Further studies

at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna with Dorit Margreiter Choy and at the Royal Danish Art Academy with Gerard Byrne.
